The 2012 Cabernet Sauvignon Maestro Raro is 100% Cabernet Sauvignon from the Rancia Piccolo vineyard adjacent to the Rancia vineyard that is celebrated for its Sangiovese. The hot vintage has crafted a thick, dark and heavily concentrated wine that delivers extra power and brawn. The first vintage of this wine was 1987. Maestro Raro shows deep lines and thick determination in the mouth. It will age forward for ten years or more.

I enjoyed a magnificent visit to Fèlsina this year to taste a wide range of old and new wines. This historic estate makes Chianti Classico wines under two different brands: Castello di Farnetella and Fèlsina (purchased in 1966). I tasted these wines with proprietor Giovanni Poggiali and Sales Director Andrea Bonivento. They were kind enough to offer a few surprises too.

When you hear the story of the effort that went into making the Colonia vineyard, you have to wonder if the fine folks at Fèlsina are absolutely mad. It took them two years of dynamite blasting to clear the imposing rock that had forced previous generations of the Poggiali family to virtually abandon this site. But an ambitious Giovanni Poggiali takes credit for making this spectacular vineyard what it is today. The wine produced here is quickly becoming the second flagship product after Fontalloro. The 2010 Chianti Classico Gran Selezione Colonia is a wine of enormous beauty and depth. This is Sangiovese at its highest expression and any doubt I had about the previous vintage (which was the first time this wine appeared as a Gran Selezione) have been washed away by this current release. What really stands out are the wine's precise mineral and graphite aromas that lend an incredible sense of focus and balance. The oak element is also beautifully integrated.

The 2012 Fontalloro (100% Sangiovese) is a stunning expression and delivers the high quality we have come to expect of this celebrated IGT Toscana wine in a less important vintage. Careful work has been done here to ensure the high quality of fruit. The Fontalloro vineyard is located on the border of the Chianti Classico and the Chianti Colli Senesi appellations. Many have called upon Fèlsina to change the wine's status to Chianti Classico Gran Selezione, but technically it can't be because of much of the vineyard is located outside the denomination limits. The bouquet is soft and rich with dark fruit and spice. In the mouth, Fontalloro reveals integrated tannins and acidity.





Sulla scia di questi studi approfonditi ci siamo appassionati ed entusiasmati nelle tante annate di Fontalloro, abbiamo poi scoperto il grande potenziale del vigneto Rancia capace, in alcune annate, di surclassare l'altro fuoriclasse con delle versioni di Chianti Classico da manuale. È, dulcis in fundo, Maestro Raro, un Cabernet di rara finezza. Il terreno su cui trovano collocazione i vari ettari vitati si compone soprattutto di macigno di arenarie quarzose, alberese misto a pizzola alluvionale, arenarie stratiformi e limo. Le diverse altitudini oscillano dai 300 ai 420 metri, colline bellissime che disegnano uno skyline prettamente toscano, vigne sparse a vista d'occhio e intarsiate da boschi e da altre colture, come l'uva. VITA - Fèlsina è un luogo senza tempo, sensazione resa possibile dalla sua storia che si perde più di mille anni addietro. Solo visitandolo si intuisce la dedizione delle generazioni che per secoli hanno contribuito alla conservazione della bellezza di questo angolo immerso nella campagna meridionale del Chianti. Oggi è grazie alle famiglie Poggiali e Mazzoclin che la realtà è un vero punto di riferimento per chi pratica viticoltura sostenibile in Toscana.

VIGNE - Abbiamo visitato alcuni degli 11 poderi che costituiscono la fattoria, ma sicuramente quello che più ci ha impressionato è il Rancia. Magnificamente esposto, con i suoi 5 ettari piantati a sangiovese da selezione massale, affascina per la presenza al suo culmine di un antico monastero benedettino. Interessante la geologia dei terreni, che spaziano dai classici chiantigiani, quindi galestro e alberego, a lingue di argille tipiche delle Crete.

VINI - Ci pare che lo stile dei vini stia attraversando un momento non così felice, ma siamo sicuri che presto torneranno a essere i capolavori di un tempo. Il Chianti Cl. 2013 (● 250.000 bt; 15 €) è floreale nei sentori e succoso al palato. Il Fontalloro 2012 (● sangiovese; 43.000 bt; 39 €) si concede con note di prugna e terra bagnata e un sorso elegante o teso. Il Chianti Cl. Rancia Ris. 2012 (● 47.000 bt; 34 €) presenta profumi floreali e di vaniglia che introducono una bocca diritta, anche se il finale è un po' dolce. Interessante il Chianti Cl. Colonia Gran Selezione 2010 (● 3.000 bt; 65 €), dagli intensi sentori di arancia e spezie; in bocca dimostra carattere e succosità e sfuma in un finale solo un po' troppo rigoroso. Autorevole prova del Maestro Rare 2012 (● cabernet sauvignon; 6.000 bt; 36 €), dalla bocca morbida, calda, affusolata e con buon allungo. Colpisce per il naso aromatico e la bocca lieve il Vin Santo del Chianti Cl. 2006 (○ 9.000 bt; 25 €).


